THE SHAPE OF THINGS TO COME

The kitchen work triangle is a concept we use in the design of efficient kitchen layouts. The primary tasks in a home kitchen are carried out between the cooker, sink and the refrigerator. These three points and the imaginary

lines between them offer you a seamless workflow. So if the shape of your kitchen is U-shaped, L-shaped, galley or otherwise a layout using the triangle at its heart can change the way you use your kitchen.
